

Cookies Policy

1) What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (computer, phone, tablet) when you visit a website. They help the website work properly, remember your preferences, and (if you allow) measure and improve performance.

We may also use similar technologies such as pixels, SDKs, and local storage (collectively, “cookies” in this policy).

2) How we use cookies

We use cookies for the following purposes:

- **Essential (Strictly Necessary):** required to operate the site and platform (login, security, session management).
- **Preferences:** remember your language, region, and platform settings.
- **Analytics (Optional):** understand how users interact with the site to improve usability and performance.
- **Marketing (Optional):** measure marketing effectiveness and show relevant messages (where applicable).

3) Your choices and consent

- Essential cookies are always used because the platform cannot function properly without them.
- Analytics and Marketing cookies are used only if you accept them through our cookie banner or cookie settings (if available).
- You can change your preferences at any time via the cookie banner/settings link (if available) or your browser settings.

4) Managing cookies in your browser

Most browsers allow you to control cookies through settings, including deleting existing cookies and blocking future cookies. If you block essential cookies, some features may not work (for example, login and secure areas).

5) Third-party cookies

Some cookies may be set by third parties we use to provide the Services (for example, hosting, video/live-class tools, payment services, analytics, or security). These third parties may process data under their own policies.

If we provide a cookie preference center, it may show a current list of categories and third-party tools used.

6) How long cookies remain on your device

Cookies may be “session cookies” (deleted when you close your browser) or “persistent cookies” (remain until they expire or you delete them). Retention depends on the cookie’s purpose and your settings.

7) Do Not Track signals

Some browsers offer a “Do Not Track” signal. There is no universal standard for how websites must respond. We handle cookies primarily through the consent options described above.
